PGVCL bags this prestigious **IPPAI POWER AWARD -2014** for the outstanding overall performance in various parameters like Reduction in Distribution loss, Financial turnaround, feeders & consumers’ metering, Reliability of power supply, meeting peak load demand, measures adopted to educate the consumers on various issues, functional performance like open access, rapid growth of infrastructure & connections, adoption of High Voltage Distribution System (HVDS), System Improvement works with focus on coastal area to revamp the network, Bet-Dwarka Island electrification, Energy efficiency and conservation, Reactive power management, development and use of in-house IT software, new initiatives for consumer service and improvement in overall office environment through record modernization.

Here it is to mention that, PGVCL has created 1132 no of Jyotigram feeders to give **24 x 7 x 365 x 3phase power supply to all villages** and 2573 no of Ag. dominant feeders for Agriculture area.

The Company has setup the Customer care centres, ATP machines, e-Payment, ECS facility and developed customer portal. Company’s 36 Towns are under the RAPDRP programme for overall improvement. Company has taken various quality management initiatives like ISO 9001:2008, NABL Accreditation of lab and new lab for 11KV CTPT testing. The Company has taken an initiative for consumers’ education on bringing awareness on electrical safety, Energy conservation and various schemes through Village meetings and *Khedut shibirs*.

The Company has achieved 7 % reduction in the Distribution loss with level of 20.55% as on March-14, converted 231 no of feeders in the HVDS, erected 62497 no of new Transformers with existing position of 4 lakh Distribution Transformer centre and created new 373 no of feeders with total 5023 no of 11 KV feeders. The Company’s 4 no of best practices are also published in the book let of India Utility Knowledge and Networking Forum.
